- You will need to complete a Bright Start Scholarship application form, and provide an academic/character reference.
- You will also need to apply for entry to the institution of your choice; if you meet the entrance criteria for your programme, the next step is to apply to enrol. You are advised to apply for the scholarship even while waiting for confirmation of acceptance into your programme.

## Where can I get an application form?

## When do applications close?

- Applications close at 5.00pm on 19 November 2008.

## When will I know?

- Successful applicants will be advised before the end of December 2008.

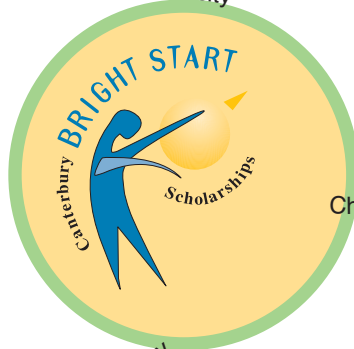

## Fees paid for first year of full-time study

Canterbury Bright Start Scholarships will pay full tuition fees for the first year of full-time study at any of the following institutions to get your education off to a bright start:

- Christchurch Polytechnic Institute of Technology
- Lincoln University
- University of Canterbury

## Who is eligible to become a Bright Start scholar?

Scholarships are available to those who:

- Have resided in the South Island, north of the Waitaki River for the last 12 months
- Have not studied full-time at a tertiary institution\*
- Have the ability to succeed at their chosen course of study
- Are likely to experience financial problems or personal hardship in tertiary study

*\*Except for STAR and TOPS courses, preparation programmes such as foundation skills or pre-health, and community education courses for secondary school students.*
